Ak-Chin's 2023 Masik Taş brought in heavy numbers for the four-day weekend, starting December 14-17, that offered free carnival and rodeo events for everyone to enjoy, located just west of Ak-Chin Circle and Harrah's Ak-Chin Casino.

There was a spectacular concert line up as well, with Midland and Parker McCollum headlining.

Thursday opened up with a morning roping and a Community Only carnival, allowing Ak-Chin families the opportunity to enjoy the carnival all to themselves a day early, taking advantage of the short lines and free games.

"The carnival featured 45 food and arts and crafts vendors, as well as free carnival rides, games, and fun zone with

inflatables and a petting zoo." Michelle Trujillo, Community Events Manager shared.

Bright and early Friday morning there were many young buckaroos up and at 'em for the Junior Rodeo. We had quite a few community members who participated and some were able to make good times and win some prize money.
